- Move files to another disk (only on machines with at least 64K of RAM);
- View and print maps of disk or individual file sectors;
- Have your disks boot up on any file, regardless of file type;
- Lock or Unlock files globally;
- Rename files;
- Create customized catalogs using inverse, flashing, or control characters.

DISK arRANGER will run on any Apple II series computer with at least 48K of RAM.
